Members in group practices are eligible for group membership discounts. The
third and additional ANCO members from a group practice where all physicians join
ANCO pay membership dues of \$325, a 25% discount. For example, all three

discount, total membership dues for the group are \$1175, or \$425+\$425+\$325, not
\$1275, or \$425+\$425+\$425. Please note that this discount is only available to
regular members when all physicians in a group practice join ANCO.
